- ➤ The music of the repertoire for the video audition shall be prepared by candidates.
- Applicants need to arrange a Piano accompanist and music sheet themselves.



- > As for YouTube video recordings please proceed as follows.
 - -YouTube video must be made within 5 months prior to the submission date.
 - -All pieces from the repertoire list must be recorded on the same day at the same venue.
 - -YouTube video must be taken horizontally.
 - -YouTube video must be unedited, taken from the same camera angle throughout and must clearly show the -Applicant's fingerings, full face and instrument.
 - -All pieces from the repertoire list must be recorded in one track.
 - -YouTube video may be excluded from judgment if it was perceived that the hand movement of the
 - -Applicant during his or her performance does not synchronize with the sound.
 - -An automatic audio volume control function of video camera (AGC, ALC, etc.) shall not be used. This is because it reduces dynamics and nuances and often results in a recording which does not accurately represent the performance.
 - -YouTube video shall not have extremely loud (or quiet) sound volume, and shall not contain noise.
